GENERAL APPLICATION:

□ Top mounted fuel level sender for tank depths of 6"-12".


CAUTION:

- Use extreme caution when working around fuel.
- Work in well ventilated area and keep all hot materials away.
 NEVER smoke near fuel tank. Extinguish all smoking material and open flames while working near fuel source.

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- Consult vehicle service manual if fuel tank must be removed
- A new gasket must be placed between the flange of the sender and the flange of the tank during final installation.






2 <u>SENDER ADJUSTMENT/INSTALLATION (Figures 1-4):</u>

- 1. Determine bracket length required for tank depth and adjust
- the rheostat position as shown on table (Figure 1 and 3)
 2. Determine float arm length required for tank depth and cut float arm wire to cut length shown on table (Figure 2 and 4).
- Determine Bent Length shown on table (Figure 4) and bend wire at right angle (90°) in direction of float (Figure 2).
- Align arm with slot in the rheostat bracket. Insert the bent pivot end of the float arm into the hole and snap the wire into the follower (Figure 2).
- 5. Secure fuel sender in tank using appropriate hardware for tank being used. Be sure to tighten hardware appropriately to ensure proper sealing of gasket. A new gasket must be placed between the flange of the sender and the flange of the tank during final installation.
